

# Consortium of ASEAN-EU-Fukuoka Universities (CASEUF) Summer Program 2024

**Period of Session:** Tuesday, 6 August 2024 – Friday, 16 August 2024  
(Moving into accommodation on 5 August; moving out on 18 August)

**Host:** Fukuoka Women's University (FWU)

**Participants:** 30 students (including 10 FWU students)

**Eligibility:** Eligible students are female students who are:

- enrolled in the CASEUF partner universities;
- in good academic standing with a grade point average of 2.3/3.0 or higher (see below for Japan Student Support Organization (JASSO) grade point average scale); and
- proficient in English for academic purposes (at least TOEFL iBT61 or the equivalent).

**Nomination of Participants:** The partner universities are asked to nominate candidates. The responsible office in each university should submit their candidates' application materials to the FWU International Center no later than 31 May 2024. Two participants from each partner university will be granted a scholarship fund of ¥80,000 and a travel expenses subsidy.

**Application:** Please submit the following materials to the contact address by e-mail.

- (1) Completed "Application Form" (Excel)
- (2) A photocopy of an academic transcript at the end of the preceding academic year
- (3) A copy of passport
- (4) A passport photo (3.5cm x 4.5cm)
- (5) A copy of an overseas traveller's insurance for the period of stay in Japan  
(A copy can be submitted right after purchasing an insurance policy.)

**Participation Fee and Other Expenses:**

- Participation fee: ¥40,000
- Wi-Fi router (if necessary)\*: ¥2,000 deposit for two weeks (refunded if returned intact)

\*Each room in the FWU International House is equipped with a wired LAN.  
You need a router to use wireless LAN.

- The following costs will be charged in case of loss or damage. (These costs are subject to change.)
  - Dormitory IC-key card: ¥2,000
  - Dormitory room key: ¥7,700
  - Dormitory chest key: ¥7,150

**Scholarship and Travel Expenses Subsidy:** Participants will receive an 80,000 JASSO/FWU scholarship fund. According to JASSO's requirements, all recipients must submit a "Completion Report" and answer the "Feedback Questionnaire" by the deadline. FWU will provide forms.

FWU will grant a maximum of 30,000 travel expenses subsidy to all participants. This subsidy may cover the return trip airfare between the international airport nearest to a participant's home university and Fukuoka Airport.

The scholarship fund and travel expenses subsidy will be paid in cash.
